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2330 HOMEWORK

The term "homework" refers to assignments students will complete outside of class. Homework assignments are designated to support the learning process. integral to the teaching process and reflect the professional judgment of teachers. Principals and Supervisors will monitor homework as a regular part of personnel evaluation.

The purposes of homework are include: s:

- 1. To reinforce learning of skills or knowledge introduced in class,; To prompt exploration;
- 2. To improve student thinking capacity by engaging in assignments that require improvisation, creativity or generalization of knowledge to new applications, or ; To provide the opportunity to engage in creative thinking;
- 3. To monitor learning.; To reinforce (learning of) skills and/or knowledge;
- 4. To preview learning; To allow for reflection and provide timely feedback;
- 5. To prompt exploration. To preview learning.

Teachers will communicate to students the purpose of a homework assignment at the time it is assigned.

The Superintendent will prepare homework regulations to implement this policy.
