Dear Mr. Neves:

Using 2011 MAC grant money, we are requesting funding for the following programs to be offered by the school district during the 2010/2011 school year.

As in past years, we ask that the schools agree to be responsible for the Cash Match as well as the "In-Kind" match as indicated below. Please note that the In-Kind Match is satisfied by use of school classrooms, materials, personnel, visual aids, etc., and not by payment of money. As always, supplies must be purchased in 2011 (Jan.-Dec.) and Clubs must continue to meet in 2011 to qualify for reimbursement through the 2011 MAC funds.

Our funding from the Governor's Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse (GCADA) remains the same as last year. All programs receiving funding from the GCADA must provide information on Alcohol, Tobacco and Other Drug (ATOD) awareness and prevention. In addition, the GCADA now requires that each program conduct evaluations to measure the impact of programs and their effectiveness.

Many of the programs remain the same in the 2011 grant. However, since there are no longer guidance counselors in the elementary schools, the Fernbrook Is Tops (F.I.T.) program will not be funded.
