Education Motions - April 20, 2009 – Version #3

1. **MOTION** to adopt the following resolution designating May 5, 2009 as National Teacher Day:

WHEREAS, teachers make public schools great; and

WHEREAS, teachers work to open students' minds to ideas, knowledge, and dreams; and

WHEREAS, teachers keep American democracy alive by laying the foundation for good citizenship; and

WHEREAS, teachers fill many roles, as listeners, explorers, role models, motivators, and mentors; and

WHEREAS, teachers continue to influence us long after our school days are only memories;

THEREFORE, be it resolved, by the Board of Education of the Township of Randolph that:

Tuesday, May 5, 2009 is proclaimed as National Teacher Day in Randolph Township Schools.

- MOTION to approve an overnight field trip for members of the Key Club to attend the Key Club District Convention in King of Prussia, Pennsylvania. The trip will take place from April 17 - 19, 2009 and students will be chaperoned by Advisor John McGrath. Total travel arrangements are estimated to cost each student \$165.00. The chaperone's registration and hotel expenses will be paid for by the Key Club treasury.
- 3. MOTION to approve an overnight field trip for members of the Randolph High School Orchestra to travel to Hummelstown and Hershey, Pennsylvania and New York City, New York. This trip will give the members the opportunity to perform and be adjudicated. The trip will take place from May 1 – 2, 2009 and students will be chaperoned by Eric Schaberg, David Sampson, Sherry Griggs and Emily James. Total travel arrangements are estimated to cost each student \$260.00. The chaperones' travel is included in the students' cost; the chaperones' hotel costs are complimentary.
- 4. MOTION to approve an overnight field trip for five members of the Forensics Speech and Debate Team to attend the Forensics Grand National Competition in Albany, New York. The trip will take place from May 22 – 25, 2009. The team will travel in a rental van driven by chaperone Eileen Waite. In accordance with Board Policy #8660, Mrs. Waite seeks Board approval to

drive this group to the event. The registration fee, hotel, van rental, fuel, and chaperone expenses will be paid by the Forensics Student Activity funds. Student costs will be approximately \$95.00 for food.

- 5. MOTION to approve an overnight field trip for two members of the Speech and Debate Team to attend the Forensics National Tournament in Birmingham, Alabama. The trip will take place from June 13 20, 2009 and students will be chaperoned by Eileen Waite. They will fly to Birmingham and then be transported by rental car driven by Mrs. Waite. In accordance with Board Policy #8660, Mrs. Waite seeks Board approval to drive this group to the events. All travel, hotel and car rental expenses plus the chaperone's expenses will be paid by the Forensics Student Activity fund. Student costs will be approximately \$350.00 for food.
- MOTION to approve all elementary staff to attend a half day workshop on June 3 and 4, 2009 regarding Lucy Caulkins and Digital Storytelling. Substitute coverage will be paid for by NCLB Title IIA funds.
- 7. **MOTION** to approve the K-8 revised Health Curriculum.
- 8. **MOTION** to approve Loretta Radulic to conduct a research study during the spring semester 2009 at Ironia School in order to complete the requirements for the NJ EXCEL program, a state-approved non-traditional program leading to administrative certification offered through the Foundation for Educational Administration.
