#### **COST**

\$190 is the cost for your child to attend the trip. The cost is comprehensive and supports the entirety of the program including:

-Boating -Team building & Adventure classes

-Appalachian Trail Hike -Pontoon Boat Ecology

-Administrative costs and supplies -Evening programs

Chaperone cost is \$30. If you sign up to be a chaperone, please send the payment to your child's homeroom teacher and indicate the check is for chaperoning. Students do not require any money during the trip for gifts or souvenirs.


