 - i. The committee reviewed the proposed budget and issues from last meeting. The committee remains concern with the overall magnitude of PD and having received the requested report (attached) on Tue, we can discuss at Tue BoE session
 - ii. The committee reviewed, page by page, the presentation deck on the Tentative Budget for use on 3-18-14 for the first public presentation on the proposed budget.
- 3. Review Last Meeting Agenda Items

- 4. School Roofing Survey, Vetting of Contractors, Food Services, HS Traffic Pattern Change, Maintenance Building
 - The NJ Office of the State Comptroller requested a survey to be completed. The survey was completed by the Business Office. It was in regards to states review on the procurement process for the repair and replacement of roofs by school districts.

- II. The Randolph Twp Police department sent the District an email recommending that all contractors be vetted by the district prior to coming on school grounds. Mr. Neves provided a recommendation to the Superintendent siting that the state does not require such screening and that all contractors are pre-approved by the state for NJ school use. Given the nature of the work contractors do, including emergency work, attempting to screen contractors prior to arrival on site would hinder the work performed. Further contactors are instructed not to have contact with staff or students. Contractors that do have contact with staff or student, such as Food Services, are required to be run though a security check. The committee concurs with the recommendation of the Business Office.
- iii. Mr. Neves report on the profitability of the new Food Service vendor. Over the past 2 months of operating the districts food service, Maschio's is showing a profit of ~\$19.3k which is a first in the district.
- IV. Mr. Neves highlighted a proposed change to the traffic pattern for the HS. The proposal would alter the current one-way road that today exits vehicles onto Millbrook Ave from the rear parking lot and change that road to two way at the northern section of the exiting road. Vehicle would enter the campus by egress at the Middle School, riding alone the RMS building to the end making a left and a quick right. Mr. Matos created a draft drawing, attached, of what we believe is the proposal. The committee had a number of concerns focused on safety and the purpose of making this change as did several member of the public present. The committee recommends that a full due diligence and safety analysis be completed and presented to the full board before implementing this proposal.
- V. Mr. Neves report that the District was ready to release its RFP to implement the last item of the referendum, the Maintenance Building. Mr. Neves expects the RFP to go out next week with a potential award in May which would allow the contractor to start in June.
