STANDARD RESIDENCY AGREEMENT SCHOOL ADMINISTRATOR

The New Jersey Department of Education, <u>James Jencarelli</u> School Administrator Mentor, and the <u>Randolph School District</u> hereby agree to provide a program of training and supervision required in N.J.A.C. 6A: 9-12.4 for <u>Jennifer Fano</u>, SS#______, who has accepted employment in a position which requires School Administrator certification, in accord with the following terms and conditions:

The New Jersey Department of Education agrees to:

- 1. Issue a provisional certificate to above named School Administrator resident valid for a period of two years after submission of appropriate forms.
- 2. Provide the district and the mentor with guidelines for training of the School Administrator resident and standardized formative and summative assessment forms:
- 3. Arrange a program of induction and continuing professional development for the School Administrator resident; and
- 4. Based upon the recommendation of the mentor, render a determination regarding the issuance of standard School Administrator certificate to the above named resident upon successful completion of the residency.

The above named mentor agrees to:

- 1. Review the School Administrator resident's background for leadership, management and teaching competencies and propose an individualized training program in cooperation with the sponsoring district;
- 2. Offer appropriate mentoring, guidance, and support to the School Administrator resident reflective of the Required Experiences as delineated in the Handbook, for a one-year period.
- 3. Form an advisory panel of practicing educators comprised of the following and convene this panel on at least three occasions for advice and to review the candidate's progress toward certification:
